



Upcoming consultation on the development and description of the ATC extraction functionality

Nordic CCM Stakeholder Meeting on intraday

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Background

- Until the single intraday coupling is able to support FB parameters, ATC-values are to be calculated based on the FB domain
- Article 20 of CCM prescribes an optimization approach to facilitate this calculation. Nordic TSOs shall
 - Develop the transitional solution for the calculation and allocation of cross-zonal capacities for the intraday timeframe (ATCE)
 - Publish the optimization approach and the parameters used, including their descriptions, purpose, and effect two months before the Nordic DA FB go-live
 - Inform stakeholders during the process
- Stakeholders may provide comments during the process
- Nordic TSOs are to take stakeholders' comments into account in the development work



The consultation

- Public consultation for all Stakeholders of Nordic CCM
- Focus: The description of the optimisation function
- Consultation period: Four weeks (October 11 to November 8, 2021)

November 8	Consultation closes



After the consultation is closed

- TSOs will then evaluate Stakeholders' comments
- Stakeholders' comments will be published along with TSOs' replies
- TSOs will take comments into account in the continued development
- TSOs will publish an updated ATCE document reflecting stakeholders' feedback as soon as possible depending on the amendments needed due to nature of the comments (end of 2021 if possible)
